Cell phone tracker app android free

Glymps allows you and your contacts to share location information with an easily understandable interface that clearly shows who is true. Use it to send an update, so others know when to expect you for a family gathering. Request an update to find out how much longer you have to wait at the restaurant for your co-worker. Or set up a group to see a map of where your friends are in relation to the theater on movie night. You can also use it to get help in an emergency quickly. This allows you to see the real-time location of those who consent to be traced (it is not legal to locate someone without their permission). Know when your partner or other family members leave and arrive at specified locations, such as work, home and school. There's also a chat feature so you can communicate about transportation or safety matters. Life360 has silver, gold and platinum plans that cost \$4.17/month, \$8.33/month and \$16.67/month, respectively. Download for: This information is designed for families or other groups who want to know each other's places in real time. You can see where everyone in your group is at any moment, and you get notifications when they leave a place (like school, work or home) or arrive at one. You can also see all group members at a glance. The app can also detect lost or stolen phones. Every contact you want to locate must give you permission to do so. Familonet is free with an option to upgrade to a Premium version starting at \$9.49. Download For: Apple's Find Me combines the features of its old Find My iPhone and Find My Friends apps into a single app for iOS13 and up. With that, you and your family members can share your locations at any time. You can set up location-based alerts, so you know when family members are safely home. Already shared? You can easily stop at any time. Those with whom you want to share your location should also have the app. It is installed on iOS devices, and it is free to use. You can also use it on all iCloud.com or in conjunction with Family Sharing. Download for: If you tend to misplaced your Android phone or tablet, this app is for you. Set it up so that when you whistle, make it a loud noise, even if it is currently in silent mode. You've probably seen apps like this before, and the style of effects offered won't appeal to everyone, but if you like your photos look a little glitchy or retro, it's one of the most capable and versatile ways to do it. There are over 100 effects in this Android app, and many of them are customizable, ensuring your glitches won't look like someone else's. As if to demonstrate the force, it's even possible to generate an image from scratch, building it up through a number of effects and tweaks. There are plenty here, even for free, but to get the absolute most out of Glitch Lab, you need to grab the Pro IAP for \$6.49/£5.99. This, at the time of writing, adds 42 extra effects, 37 new parameters for free effects, increases the output quality, and more. Doodle something, then point your phone's camera at the doodle from inside the app, and you can copy it and paste it on top of the world around you in augmented reality. You can also change the color of the doodle and even make very basic animations by copying multiple doodles and have the app cycle through it. You can then record and save the results. DoodleLens probably isn't an Android app you'll use often, and we found it a little hit and miss at recognizing our doodles, but when it works it raises a smile, which is all you can really ask for at \$1.99/£1.89.PixticaFree+ multiple subscriptionsPixtica is one of many tools hoping to replace your phone's default camera. Camera varies greatly, and their success largely depends on your phone making and modeling, but Pixtica is a decent option if you're looking for something new. It's packed with features, including numerous filters, a GIF recorder, panorama, panorama, manual controls, and oddities like a 'Planet' mode, showing images warps in a sphere-like form using Pixtica's advanced stereographic projection algorithm. There are also all sorts of other modes, whether you're taking photos or shooting video, and the app is laid out intuitively. However, while many of the features are free, you'll have to pay to unlock higher resolutions and remove watermarks when using filters. The payment also gets you other things, but these are the most important things that make the purchase close to essential if you plan on using Pixtica. With 'animations' we mean basically light routes, but there are different ways they are animated, numerous colors you can choose, and you can choose exactly where they appear on images and how big they are. Essentially, it's an app that does one thing, but does it very well. Once you've added an animation, you can save the result to your phone's gallery, ready to share. The basic app is free, but for either a one-time fee or a monthly subscription, you can remove ads and unlock additional customization options, as well as unlock the ability to remove the Scribble watermark from your creations. If you like the app, it's worth paying for, but you can get a good taste of it without spending anything. Photo WatermarkFree +\$0.99/£0.89 monthly subscriptionPhoto Watermark does exactly what the name indicates - it allows you to add watermarks to photos - but the types of watermarks you can add are very varied. Not only can you add custom text as a watermark (including changing the font, size, and color), you can also use your signature (or any other handwritten text) as a watermark by writing on the screen. You can also apply stickers, a timestamp, a location, a mosaic effect, or 'graffiti' (which basically only allows you to go wild on your images with a digital paintbrush). Whether you want to protect your photo or just log on when and where it's taken, there needs to be a tool here to match. Photo Watermark is free, but it's pretty heavy on advertising. For \$0.99/£0.89 a month you can get rid of it, but unless you add watermarks to a ton of images, it's probably not worth it. StoryZ Photo Movement & CinemagraphFree +\$1.99/£1.79 monthly subscriptionStoryZ Photo Movement & Theatre is a photo editing Android app in two parts. The first of these is 'Ripple', a mode that lets you movement at a static can add by drawing the area and direction you want the motion to happen. It can be an effective way to make it look like water or smoke is moving for example, or simply adding a slightly trippy effect to things that can expect to be static. The best ones will appear on the homepage and competition page of the app. You can use StoryZ for free, but if you find that you have more of a talent for it than we do then there's also StoryZ Premium, which for a monthly subscription removes ads and watermarks, increases the allowable length of videos in Motion Mode, improves the tools in Ripple mode and lets you save and share in high resolution. KineMaster KineMasterFree + £2.91 (about \$3.70) monthly subscriptionKineMaster is probably one of the most powerful video editors on Android, but it's also intuitive enough that anyone can enjoy it. The app lets you add audio and visual filters to visuals, add text, stickers, and other overlays, frame-by-frame videos, adjust the speed, add transition effects and a whole lot more. You can also record videos directly from the KineMaster app. It might feel a little cramped on a phone screen, but otherwise everything works fine. You can use the KineMaster Android app for free, but all of your videos will have a KineMaster watermark and you can't use it commercially. To remove the watermarks, allow commercial use and unlock additional assets (such as bonds and overlay) you must pay a subscription, but at £2.91 (about \$3.70) a month it remains affordable. Moment – Pro Camera \$1.99/£1.79A truly large camera app likely should both avoid littering and packed full manual controls, so you can capture an image exactly the way you want it, but it's a tough balance to hit, and some management. PhotoDirectorFree + optional subscriptionYour phone may have a powerful camera, but chances good that it doesn't have much in the way of photo editing tools. Fortunately, PhotoDirector is an Android app that can fill up Gaps. This app allows you to customize the tone, saturation, white balance and colors of photos you previously took, as well as adding filters and effects, which you can adjust the power of and apply to all or just part of an image. You can also add text, stickers, frames, change the perspective, reflect the image, cut sections, and a whole lot more. There are many tools, but PhotoDirector is easy to navigate and you can always undo your changes, so you're safe to experiment. And that's just the editing part of the program. There's also a built-in camera, which lets you shoot new photos with multiple effects and see live through the viewer how they'll affect the image. LightX Photo EditorFree + \$3.69/£3.49 IAPIf you want an all-in-one photo editor for Android then LightX Photo Editor is a good choice, not least because most of the features are free. You can merge photos, add effects and filters, selectively apply colors to regions of an image, customize the color balance, smooth and grind images, harvest them, turn them, draw on them, add frames and stickers, add text, collages and create a whole lot more. It's all handled by the Android app's intuitive interface; bring up the main menu with a tap, select the category of edits you want to make (filters or frames, for example) and you'll be taken to a custom with all the relevant options. Most of it is pretty self-explanatory, but there are also manual videos for if you're stuck, and for a one-off \$3.69/£3.49 IAP you can get rid of ads, unlock additional stickers and frames, and add the ability to save images in PNG format. SKRWT \$1.49/£1.39There is very much photo editing Android apps, but while most offer filters and effects little allows you to change the perspective of a photo in the way SKRWT does. There are no stickers here, no makeup modes and no real effects. Instead, there are tools to shift the perspective, change the relationship and correct lens distortion. You can also rotate, twist, mirror and crop images, but SKRWT isn't interested so much in modifying photos in unnatural ways, as in making them look exactly as you suggested when you took them.
